ORIGIN: Paarl

CULTIVAR: 55% Cabernet Franc, 30% Merlot, 15% Shiraz

ANALYSIS: ALC.14.00% R.S. 2.60g/1 T.A. 5.60g/1 PH. 3.45

VINIFICATION: Grapes were harvested seperately at 24°B, destemmed and transferred to fermentation tanks. After the addition of selected yeasts, the juice, together with the skins, were allowed to ferment at controlled temperatures of 25°C - 28°C. Regular pump overs ensured good colour and tannin extraction.

MATURATION: Merlot and Shiraz aged for 12 months in 2nd, 3rd and 4th fill French oak barrels.

BOTTLING DATE: 14 July 2020

	This wine can be enjoyed now, but will continue to improve for several years.
T	Medium bodied wine with plum and red berry flavours. Wine has well integrated and soft tannins. Hints of spice.
X	Recommended as a good partner to roasts and venison.
