VINIFICATION: Specially selected grapes from different vineyard blocks on the farm were harvested at 24.5°B, destemmed and transferred to open fermentation tanks. After the addition of selected yeasts, the juice, together with the skins, were allowed to ferment at controlled temperatures of 25° - 28°C.

MATURATION: 18 months - 80% French oak and 20% American oak. New barrel component is 60% and the rest 2nd fill barrels.

BOTTLING DATE: 28 January 2021

	This wine can be enjoyed now, but will benefit from further careful maturation of 5-7 years.
•	This Shiraz has been made from grapes picked at optimum ripeness and vinified using a combination of modern and traditional techniques. This wine is full bodied with lovely rich berry fruit flavours and piquant pepper supported by tones of spicy oak gained from aging in a combination of American and French oak barrels.
