Designation : EUROPEAN COMMUNITY WINE
Grape varieties : 90% Tempranillo / 10% Grenache
Origin : Blend from grapes from different countries : South of France, Spain (Mancha region) & south of Italy

Sensory characteristic :

-  **Colour :** Ruby red, medium intensity.
-  **Nose :** Discreet, clear, a slight note of fruits with no complexity.
-  **Palate :** Supple, clear, without bitterness and astringency. Semi-dry wine, round, pleasant.

Recommendations : This wine may be served by itself or with a large number of dishes such as red meat, cold meats, salad and cheese.
